



Job posting: CSG 2025 Cycling Coach

The Cycling Association of Yukon (CAY) is seeking a Cycling Coach(es) (1 - 2 positions). Based on the needs of our athletes and organization, this position may be split into several positions responsible for specific disciplines. We encourage applicants to apply with a statement of interest around discipline(s). The CAY board is committed to assembling an excellent coaching and support team and will be collaborating with our partners at Sport Yukon and Cycling Canada as part of the hiring process.

Job description

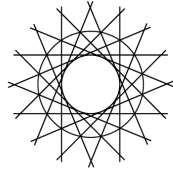
Applicants are expected to coach and train Yukon road, MTB and/or para cycling athletes for the 2025 Canada Summer Games. This may include competitions and events inside and outside the Yukon.

Duties may include

- Biweekly (minimum) training for *each* cycling discipline:
 - Road/Para (up to 15 athletes)
 - MTB (up to 10 athletes)
- Develop and coordinate training plans, racing skills and goals for athletes.
- Organize travel and volunteer assistance for travel to events.
- Manage a budget for training, events, travel and supplies.
- Assess athletes for high performance
- Work collaboratively with the CSG 2025 Committee and contracted or Volunteer Assistant Coach(es) on selection criteria, qualifying events and team selection
- Attendance at all relevant events up to and including the 2025 Canada Summer Games

Expectations

- Part-time employment.
- Subject to funding, the applicant will work approximately 800 hours of service in a contractual period from Sep 30, 2024 - Aug 31, 2025 with roughly 400 hours for road/para and 400 hours for cross-country mountain biking. Hours will be adjusted based on the needs of athletes.
- Approximately 75% hours of service will be compensated.

- Uncompensated hours may include time spent at events not coaching or engaged in activities directly related to the event
- Maintain a healthy and respectful relationship with CAY board and partner organizations

Requirements

- Must reside in the Yukon
- Valid Class 5 Drivers license (Class 4 preferred) and clean drivers abstract available upon request.
- Must possess or be willing to obtain specific sport related training (Safe Sport, Ethics in Sports, Code of Conduct, etc).
- Must be certified under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Competition Stream in accordance with the CSG 2025 technical package
- Must complete a Criminal Records Check for Vulnerable Sector Individuals (RCMP).
- Must possess or be willing to obtain Standard First Aid/CPR-C
- Must obtain a UCI coaching membership upon acceptance of the position.

September 30, 2024 - August 31, 2025.

To be determined based on experience, training and skill set.
